GOV.-ELECT Bill Ritter has named Pueblo native Frances Koncilja to co-chair his Colorado Promise Inaugural Committee. She will be joined by businessman James Crowe and his wife, Pamela Crowe.

The three will set up the incoming governor's inauguration ceremony and related festivities. Ms. Koncilja, 57, grew up in Pueblo and is a 1969 graduate of Southern Colorado State College, now Colorado State University-Pueblo.

A graduate of the University of Colorado law school, she has been an attorney since 1972 and serves on Denver Mayor John Hickenlooper's Infrastructure Task Force. Ms. Koncilja is president of the City Club of Denver and past president of the Colorado Bar Association, just to name two of her many professional accomplishments.

Gov.-elect Ritter did well to ask this Pueblo native to help organize the event that will usher him into office.
